Welcome to our second issue of The Coastal Bulletin. Here you'll find news around upcoming brews, events and a list of the great local bottle shops which now stock our cans.

Three new brews

We've got three new brews (as well as a new batch of Boomerang Beach Pale Ale) in the tanks at the moment and a double batch of Town Lager going into the tanks early next week.

First out of the tanks will be 'Treachery XPA'. This pale yet bold fruity ale betrays traditional beer styles being extra pale, extra flavoursome and 'eXperimental!' It will be available in the Tasting Room on Friday 22 September and at the Wallis Lake Oyster & Craft Beer Festival on Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 September.

Next up will be 'Diamond Beach Pilsner'. As the weather starts hotting up, this will be a refreshing pale lager brewed with 100% New Zealand hops. This will come out of the tank in time for the long weekend in October and we will showcase this beer around the Great Lakes Food Trail activity.

Our German Style 'Submarine Kolsch' is expected to be ready in early October. Named after Submarine Beach which is home to the buried wreck of a 1922 Dutch (close to Germany!) built submarine.

All three brews will be available in cans as well as on tap in the Tasting Room.

Upcoming beer experiences!

23 - 24 September

From 11am – 5pm on both days we'll be down at the Wallis Lake Oyster & Craft Beer Festival at Hamiltons', 1 Palm Street, Tuncurry. As well as terrific craft beer, there will be local wines, an oyster eating competition and games, all day live music and kids entertainment.

30 September - 2 October

As part of this year's activities around the Great Lakes Food Trail, the brewery Tasting Room will be open from 12noon to 4pm on Saturday 30 September and Sunday 1 October. On the Saturday and Sunday evenings we will also be down at the Kingfisher Café at Blueys

Beach where a selection of our beers will be food matched and available for tastings. With the Monday after the Food Trail being a public holiday, we'll also open the Tasting Room from 2.30pm – 5.30pm on Monday 2 October.

As part of Sydney Craft Beer Week (20 – 29 October) we are running a 'Cruise, Tour and Paddle' event in Forster in association with Free Spirit Cruises on Sunday 22 October. The event will include a cruise around Wallis Lake with lunch and beer tasting on board, a brewery tour and a tasting at the brewery.
