## Beers

### Three summer brews

Over the last three weeks we've released three new brews.

**Treachery XPA** (ABV 4.5%) - this pale yet bold fruity ale betrays traditional beer styles being eXtra pale, eXtra flavoursome and 'eXperimental! This is available from the Tasting Room as well as in cans. For those based in Maitland and Newcastle we've also just delivered kegs to The Pourhouse and the Prince of Wales bottlo' where it should, shortly, be on tap.

Our 'Diamond Beach Pilsner' (ABV 5.0%) is also now available on tap in the Tasting Room as well as in cans. This is a refreshing crisp pale lager brewed with 100% New Zealand hops. This has just gone on tap at The Roundabout Inn at Gloucester.



Our German Style 'Submarine Kolsch' (ABV 4.3%) - named after Submarine Beach which is home to the buried wreck of a 1922 built submarine - went into our tasting room this past weekend.

### Upcoming releases

In the tanks at the moment we have a new hoppy IPA called Pebbly IPA due out at the beginning of November and two batches of Town Lager (one due out in the next week and the second late November). We've also got another double batch of Boomerang Beach Pale Ale going into the tank today!

By popular request, we will also be brewing a wheat beer in the coming weeks!
