Tickets are now onsale for GABS. The Melbourne event is on 18 - 20 May at the Royal Exhibition Centre and the Sydney event on Saturday 2 June at Sydney Showground Olympic Park. Our Festival Beer – 'Double Treachery IPA' will be on the Container Bar at both the Melbourne and Sydney events.

'Double Treachery' is a double IPA based on Treachery XPA which we brewed last year and which became a firm favourite with many. So for GABS, we figured we would give everyone double what they loved – double malt, double hops and double ABV – Double Treachery weighs in at 9.1% alcohol!!
