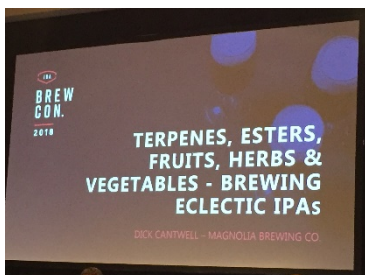
Congratulations to any of you that have (almost) completed Dry July – only one week to go before you can sit down with a The Coastal Brewing Company beer and celebrate your willpower !

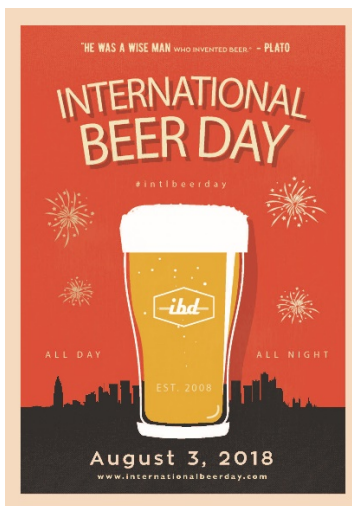
