7th September saw the launch of one of our three summer beers – **Cellito IPA** (ABV 6.8%). Look out for this hazy, juicy IPA in bars and bottleshops in Port Macquarie, Newcastle and Sydney including Tacking Point Tavern bottleshop, The Prince of Wales bottleshop, The Firestation Hotel, The Blind Monk, The SG (Spooning Goats), The Dove & Olive, Forest Lodge Hotel and the Liquor Emporium.



Solar - another natural ingredient

We are going greener !! As you may know we already treat our waste water on site using Biogill technology.

On 13th and 14th September we are going further and installing 84 solar panels (26kW) on the roof of our building. This will help us further ensure we play our role in protecting the environment and reduce the electricity we purchase. Photos to follow next month!
